3. Santa's Cookies in a Jar



What you will need for the tags:

- o printer
- card stock
- scissors
- Glue dots

What you will need for the jar:

- 1 quart Mason Jar
- 1 1/3 cup all-purpose flour, spooned into measuring cup & leveled
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup rolled oats
- 3/4 cup M&Ms
- 1/2 cup brown sugar, packed
- 1/2 cup white granulated sugar
- 1/4 3/4 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips (depends on if you have room)

Instructions:

- 1 Mix the flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt together.
- 2 Layer all the ingredients in a 1 quart mason jar in the order listed.
- 3 Print this FREE DIY Printable PDF file {Santa's Cookies in a Jar Tags} on card stock and cut out.
- 4 Attach recipe tags to front and back of jar with glue dots.
- 5 The conversion of 350 degrees fahrenheit to celsius is 177 celsius.
- 6 Enjoy!



DIRECTIONS

Heat oven to 350 degrees F. Grease a cookie sheet or line with parchment paper. In a medium bowl, beat together 1/2 cup softened butter, 1 egg and 1 teaspoon vanilla extract until fluffy. Add the entire jar of cookie mix while stirring until well blended. Roll the cookie dough into 1 1/2 inch balls and place onto baking sheet. Bake for 10 minutes, or until edges start to brown. Cool on baking sheets, or remove to cool on wire racks. Makes 24 cookies.
